ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA TRAVEL ADVISORY

16th April 2020

In its ongoing effort to control the spread of the virus into and within the borders of Antigua and Barbuda, the Government has taken the decision to continue the currently imposed restriction on **ALL inbound commercial traffic until 23rd April 2020 in the first instance.**

However, while the government continues to evaluate the present situation, regional inbound and outbound passenger and cargo flights by LIAT, private jets, small private aircraft, and flights and customary small carriers will be permitted to land subject to special approval.

All international commercial inbound flights, except for LIAT, **must be empty.** Any airline wishing to fly in empty aircraft in order to collect citizens of their countries for return to their originating cities will be allowed to do so with proper advance notification and authorization. **NO nationals will be allowed entry on inbound flights organized to collect foreign nationals.**

During this period, citizens of Antigua and Barbuda as well as resident diplomats will be allowed entry. All citizens arriving on LIAT/private flights will be quarantined. **Citizens returning from the Dominican Republic will be required to undergo two (2) weeks quarantine prior to return AND two (2) weeks upon return to Antigua and Barbuda.** Flight organizers are kindly asked to provide advance passenger information of the scheduled arrival of citizens in order to facilitate the necessary quarantine. **ENDS**
